Noting That: The Student Council, in order to truly represent the students at Salem High, is tasked with many responsibilities that require a lot of work

Additionally Noting That: The work load of Student Council members is typically high and the responsibilities placed upon the membership is a large load.

Additionally Noting That: The Student Council, being a large group of Students, is enabling some members to hide and simply receive recognition of Student Council Membership without any recorded proof of any quality work being done as a member.

The Council resolves that:

I. 5 Standing Committees be established:

A) Fundraising Committee

a) Tasked with researching and running fundraisers for the Student Council

B) School Spirit Committee

a) Tasked with researching ways the council can increase School Spirit

C) School Improvement Committee

a) Tasked with researching ways the Council can improve Salem High

D) Community Service Committee

a) Tasked with researching and running community service events for the Council

E) Publicity Committee

a) Tasked with advertising Council Events and coordinating with local news agencies.

II. Members of the Student Council, in order to fulfill membership, must hold membership on a Standing Committee and maintain regular attendance to Committee meetings.

III. Membership of a Standing Committee will be capped at ten (10) members each and no more than three (3) per class, both including Chairperson(s). Membership will be rolling (first-come-first-served.)

IV. Meetings of the committees are to be arranged and planned by the the Committee Chairs.

V. Committees Chairs shall be invited through the consensus of the Executive Board and shall have the option of accepting the position or not. Committees may not have more than two (2) Chairpersons.

VI. The Council will have the right to establish Ad Hoc Committees at the will of the Council at

large.

VII. In order to establish committees, a resolution must be passed with the proper justification to be reviewed by the Council.

VIII. Committees may not authorize any spending. Spending authorization must be made by the Council.
